OMH respectfully submits the attached contract package for OSC review and consideration of approval.

The contract is for DrWanted.com at Central New York Psychiatric Center. The candidate chosen is listed below along with the contract total.

This mini-bid was released on 1/6/21 and bids were due on 1/13/21. Dr. Polur was the lowest candidate and only candidate presented and the facility has tentatively selected her, pending approval. This release is as a result of the previously awarded vendor, Dr. Redondo, not starting at the facility on 1/19/21, as planned. No disputes have been received.

OMH finds the hourly rate of \$399.00 justified and the lack of bids received reasonable due to the nature of the placement. This is an Outpatient, forensic facility, which requires additional training and experience and greatly lowers the pool of interested and qualified candidates. Additionally, this hourly rate mirrors that of similar placements at Midstate MH Unit (mini-bid #054) and Great Meadows MH Unit (#004A).

Section 3: Terms and Conditions

- All mini-bids and LT placements are subject to the terms and conditions of the approved LT Back-drop contract. Additional terms and conditions may be applied as part of the mini-bid process, provided that such additional terms and conditions do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the Back-drop contracts
- 2. Facility-specific Clauses: LT Contractors and Psychiatrists are subject to Facility-specific clauses as attached to this mini-bid form.
- 3. OMH reserves the right to cancel placements at any time. OMH shall terminate a Back-drop contract or placement established through this mini-bid process immediately upon written notice of termination to the Contractor, if, at OMH's sole discretion, the Contractor fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the Agreement, and/or with any laws, rules, regulations, polices, and procedures affecting the Agreement. (Back-drop Contract, pg. 7, State of New York Agreement, section IIIB).

Furthermore, OMH reserves the right to cancel any placement for convenience or mutual agreement upon 30 days written notification to the Contractor that the services of an individual placement are no longer required. The Contractor agrees that OMH will have no further financial obligation for such placements upon Contractor receipt of written termination notice and the 30-day notice period has lapsed. In no event shall the State be liable for expenses and obligations after the placement terminate date. Doctors whose placements are cancelled by mutual agreement will be ineligible from being submitted for new mini-bids for a period of 120 days. Doctors whose

placements are cancelled for convenience because either the required service has been completed, or OMH has determined the services are no longer needed, will immediately be eligible to bid on new mini-bids following their last day of service under an existing mini-bid contract.

Types of Placement Cancellation:

- a) Convenience or Mutual Agreement: A placement will be cancelled in this manner when (1) the OMH Facility has deemed that they no longer need the placement or (2) the Locum Tenens psychiatrist must withdraw from the placement for reasons other than "for Cause" and has provided 30 days' notice. In both instances, the incumbent LT Agency will have five (5) business days to present an acceptable replacement candidate at the exact same hourly rate as the departing psychiatrist (Back-drop Contract, pg. 30, Appendix D – Scope of Work).
- b) Cause: A placement will be cancelled in this manner when a Locum Tenens psychiatrist is not performing the duties of their placement. When a placement is cancelled for Cause, the LT Agency forfeits their hold on the placement and a new mini-bid will be released to fill the vacancy (Back-drop Contract, pg. 30, Appendix D Scope of Work). Upon termination, the LT Agency will be advised that this individual is not to be presented in the future for future placements at any OMH Facility, pending vendor/doctor responsibility review.
- **4.** Candidates who are already placed at OMH Facilities are ineligible for submission under this mini-bid. Repeated violation of this may result in a vendor's backdrop contract being terminated.
- More than one candidate may be offered by an LT Agency, but each candidate must be presented at the same hourly rate.

Section 4: Contractor Attestation:

As the Contractor's Authorized Representative, I certify that all information concerning a candidate's experience and background information presented in this proposal submission is accurate and complete.
